2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.

One of the best and most impactful ways of teaching the students in pandemic period is online teaching to complete their syllabus in an effective manner. Online, students need to feel an instructor presence in their classes. Thorough explanations and effective communication helped to fulfil their need and can transform a Dental subjects online teaching into a great one. During the pandemic situation the Dental students have given online flash lectures in addition to procedural videos illustrating laboratory steps in addition to traditional face to face lectures and live laboratory demonstrations. Online tutorial links were provided for the students through Google class room, Zoom App, Whats app group sharing & Twitter etc., and asked for their submission through online only. Further, Twitter and Google Moderator were utilized as a source of communication to enhance the interaction between students and teachers and to provide a constant and immediate feedback. At the end of every session, students were assessed through online test which is intimated in advance with stipulated time to submit. Students' appraisal of the tools like feedback, value of online learning through video presentation and demonstration, evaluation of their involvement by their immediate response in online class were important factors and that are essential to improve the quality of online learning system. The implementation of first online learning attempt during COVID 19 lockdown period was useful to identify the readiness of the students through their response to move online. This also helped us to improve the quality of online learning.
